# **Board of Trustees**

Much of the discussion by our members these past months have been focused on the hiring of a new Executive Director and the search process for a new rabbi. Both these positions are critical to Beth Torah's leadership, but let's not forget the importance of our Board of Trustees, often referred to as "Directors."

Increasingly, members are inquiring about how to serve on the Board and how policy at our synagogue is made. We're pleased about the interest, so here's a very quick summary of how the Board operates.



Beth Torah's by-laws requires that the Board consist of no fewer than twelve members. There is no maximum. The selection of Trustees begins with a recommendation from the Nominating Committee

to the Board, then approval by the Board and, finally election by the congregation at our Annual Meeting. Trustees are elected to a three-year term and are eligible to be re-elected to a second three-year term.

Board and executive committee meetings are open to all members except when in Executive Session. At that time personnel issues are discussed. Meeting agendas and minutes (except for those relating to Executive Sessions) are open for all members to review.


